

**AUGUST 21, 2007**  
**Pilesgrove Township**  
**Work Session**  
**Minutes**

Deputy Mayor Kille called the work session meeting of the Pilesgrove Township Committee to order at 9:00 A.M. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Deputy Mayor Kille stated that the meeting was in compliance with the New Jersey Sunshine law, and the Clerk read the annual notice:

This meeting is called pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings law. This meeting of August 21, 2007 was included in a list of meetings notice sent to the Today's Sunbeam and the Elmer Times on January 3, 2007, posted on the bulletin board at the Municipal Building on January 3, 2007 and has remained continuously posted as the required notices under the Statute. In addition, a copy of this notice is and has been available to the public and is on file in the office of the Municipal Clerk.

Deputy Mayor Kille advised that proper notice having been given; the Clerk is directed to include this statement in the minutes of this meeting.

Motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to authorize the execution of the 2008 New Jersey Dept of Transportation Municipal Aid application. Ayes all.

Discussion took place on the request by Ms. Theresa Huckoby that the Township install a street light at 70 Cedar Lane. The Superintendent of Public Works has inspected the roadway, and reported that there is no curve, grade or site distance issue. Motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to authorize the Clerk to advise Ms. Huckoby that the Township will not be installing a light at this location at this time. Ayes all.

Discussion took place on the request by Mr. James Tunstall that the Township install drainage pipe along Cedar Lane at his address, 74 Cedar Lane. Mr. Tunstall had stated at the August 14, 2007 Township Committee meeting that there had been a pipe, but the Township removed it. Russell English, Township Superintendent of Public Works, does not recall there ever being a pipe along the roadway. Mr. English reported that there does not appear to be a drainage problem along the road way, the water collects on private property. It has currently been raining for almost 3 straight days, and the area has received 1 ½ inches of rain. Even under the present conditions, there is no significant flooding. Motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to authorize the Clerk to advise Mr. Tunstall that the Township will take no action with regard to his request at this time. Ayes all.

The Clerk advised Committee that at the August 14, 2007 meeting, Committee approved Resolution 07-082, authorizing the assignment of a tax certificate. The Township Tax collector has subsequently been advised that bankruptcy had been filed on the property in question prior to the request for assignment, so by law, the assignment cannot take place. Motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller approve the Resolution 07-085, rescinding Resolution 07-082. Ayes all.

Motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to approve the purchase of a new exterior bulletin board for the Municipal Building from Adirondack Direct at a cost of \$422.00 plus \$65.00 shipping. (quotes attached). Ayes all.

Motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to approve the cost of cleaning the rugs in the Township courtroom by Stanley Steemer at a cost of \$310.00 (quotes attached). Ayes all.

Motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to open the meeting to the public. There being no public comment, motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to close the public comment portion of the meeting. Ayes all.

Motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to adjourn at 10:20 A.M.
