

**March 25, 2008**  
**Pilesgrove Township**  
**Work Session**  
**Minutes**

Mayor Bickford called the work session meeting of the Pilesgrove Township Committee to order at 9:00 A.M. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Bickford stated that the meeting was in compliance with the New Jersey Sunshine Law, and the Clerk read the annual notice:

Motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to authorize the Clerk to place an advertisement in the paper canceling the bid process for the lease of property owned by the Township (the "Musemeci parcel") to further investigate the term of the lease. Ayes all.

Motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to open the public comment portion of the meeting. Ayes all.

Resident Cheryl Reardon requested an explanation of a discussion at last week's work session that had been referred to Committee from the Township Planning Board. Mayor Bickford and Committeeman Miller explained that the ordinance in question has to do with amending the definition of minor subdivision. Ms. Reardon expressed here concern that numerous minor subdivisions could have an effect on the Township's COAH obligation.

Resident Phyllis Sauer updated Committee on a recent Board of Education meeting that included a presentation on the upcoming referendum to the voters on expansion and renovations of the school facilities.

There being no further public comment, motion made by Kille, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Miller to close the public comment portion of the meeting. Ayes all.
