Michelle Robinson and Judy Dawson residents from building #10 at Baileys Corner came to discuss their concerns with situations that have been taken place outside their building. Both stated the loitering, drinking, loud noises late at night have now become worse and moving closer to their building. They have gone to management and nothing has been done. The Clerk has reached out to the State Police regarding this issues and all residents should call 9-1-1 directly when this activity is happening. The Police can inforce municipal ordinances for all that are breaking the rules.
